



## Elsie Louise Fischer

Elsie Louise Fischer passed away on April 20, 2020 after a prolonged illness.

Elsie was born on November 11, 1928 in Bell Settlement, the daughter of Fritz and Augusta Schroeder. She was the youngest of the family of three brothers and two sisters. Elsie married Joseph Fischer on April 21, 1951 in Giddings. Affectionately known as “Grandma Country” by her grandkids.
