



Mrs. Enedina Villalobos Garza

May 14, 1930 - January 12, 2015

Mrs. Enedina “Bonnie” Villalobos Garza, widowed of Jesus Hector Garza, died peacefully surrounded by her family, Monday January 12th, 2015 due to the infirmities of her advanced age at 84 years old.

They both moved back and forth from Monterrey to Caldwell for many years and devoted both their time and love to their children and three granddaughters, Jesusito Garza who deceased at birth, Hector Javier Garza married to Araceli Garza, Melba Nelia Garza-Galls married to Gregory Galls, and three granddaughters, Lauren Gabrielle Galls, Brook Danielle Galls, and Andrea Garza. Mrs.Garza had been a member of this community for over 35 years and dedicated a lot of her time to the church. She was a homemaker and enjoyed cooking, gardening, attending church, telling stories about her past, also singing and dancing. She was always very social and enjoyed spending time with her friends and family. But most of all she loved to pray the rosary every night and building a closer relationship with God. She was never afraid to share her beliefs and faith with others. Mrs.Garza had an open heart as well an opened home that welcomed everyone that entered her life.

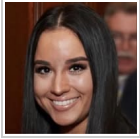
