



Ernest Eugene "Pete" Lindsey

February 15, 1923 - March 18, 2018

Graveside services for Ernest Eugene "Pete" Lindsey, age 95 of Gause, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 21, 2018 in the Gause Cemetery in Gause, Texas with Rev. Adam Straznicky of St. Johns United Methodist Church in Rockdale officiating. There will be no visitation.

Ernest was born in Gause, Texas on February 15, 1923 to Thomas Shirley and Lula (Garrison) Lindsey. He was raised in Gause, and lived in Houston where he worked as a television and appliance repairman. He returned to Gause in the 1960's. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corp during World War II. He served as Crew Chief onboard a bomber and was a P.O.W. in Germany. He was honorably discharged as a Sargent with the 306th Bomb Group 368th Squadron.

Ernest passed away Sunday morning, March 18, 2018 in the Wellington Place Living & Rehabilitation Center in Temple, Texas. He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Charles, Albert and Marvin Lindsey and two sisters, Ruby Stracener and Vivian Adams.

Surviving are, a brother, Bobby Lindsey of Gause and a number of nieces and nephews.
