



Ervin David Miller

November 17, 1926 - December 3, 2021

Funeral services for Ervin D. Miller, 95 of Bastrop, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at New Hope Lutheran Church in McDade, Texas with Rev. Caleb Williams officiating. Burial will follow in the Siloah Cemetery near McDade. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, December 8, 2021 from 10:30 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, December 9, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present on Wednesday evening from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Ervin David Miller was born on November 17, 1926 to Joseph and Ella (Proske) Miller in Austin, Texas. He was baptized on December 12, 1926 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Austin and was confirmed on March 17, 1940 by Rev. KG Manz also at St. Paul Lutheran Church. His confirmation verse was 1 Corinthians 6:20, "Ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's". He graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School. The day after graduation, he left for San Antonio to serve in the US Navy on the USS Hart during World War II. After serving his time in the Navy, he continued his high school job working at Kara-Vel Shoe store, where he worked for 40 years. He met the love of life, Alice Ruth Bohot in March 1957. They were married on June 7, 1958 at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester and were happily together for the next 63 years. In 1968, Diane Miller came to live with them, and they raised her as their

daughter. They made their home in Austin. They were active members at St. Paul Lutheran Church, where he served as an usher and on many committees, until 1980 when they moved to Bastrop. They joined Good Shepherd Lutheran Church where he also served on many committees there. Ervin and Alice helped start up a new church in McDade in 2010, New Hope Lutheran Church, where they were active members. He enjoyed spending time and volunteering with the American Legion Post 533 in Bastrop. Ervin loved playing dominos any chance he got. He enjoyed building bar-b-que pits for himself, family, and friends. He would help anyone with any project that needed to be done. Ervin also loved working on the Bohot family farm in Pin Oak.

Ervin David Miller was peacefully called to his Heavenly home the evening of Friday, December 3, 2021 with his beloved wife by his side at his home in Bastrop.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Joseph & Ella Miller; sister, Rosie & George Prellop; brother, Herbert Miller, and brother-in-law, Hilton Bohot.

He is survived by his wife, Alice B. Miller of Bastrop; daughter, Diane & Loren Vega of Ingleside on the Bay; sister-in-law, Neva Bohot of Arkansas; nephews & nieces, Larry Prellop & Linda Kirksey, Leonard Prellop & wife Kathy, Bradley Bohot, Brenda Coleman and Belinda Black; 11 great nieces and nephews; 15 great-great nieces and nephews, along with many other family members and friends.

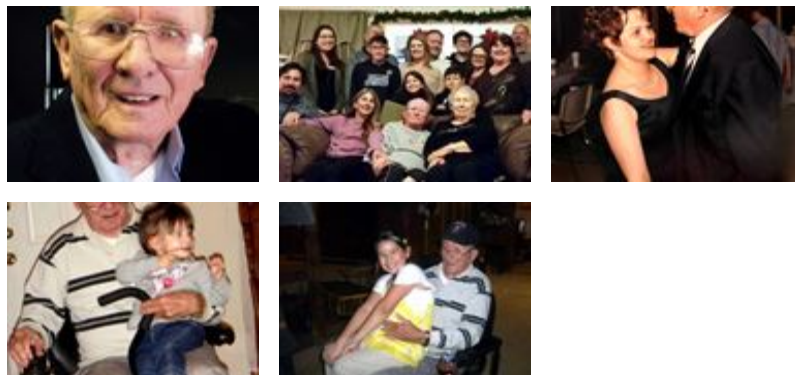
