



Erwin Albert Iselt

November 10, 1930 - March 4, 2019

Funeral services for Erwin Iselt, 88, of Old Dime Box, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, March 8, 2019 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas with Rev. Bernie Schey officiating. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Dime Box. Visitation will be held on Thursday, March 7, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, March 8, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Iselt family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Erwin Albert Iselt was born on November 10, 1930 to Martin and Clara (Schulze) Iselt in Loebau, Texas. He was baptized on November 27, 1930 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. C. Durrow. Erwin was confirmed on May 20, 1945 by Rev. G. Brust at Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas.

On December 25, 1952, Erwin was united in marriage with Magdalena Symank at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Max Studtmann officiating. This union was blessed with two sons, Wayne and Dan. Erwin served in the U.S. Army from May 13, 1952 until May 12, 1954. He was in business all his life with Iselt's Blacksmith Shop, then started Iselt's Pump Shop and Iselt's Concrete Shop. Erwin was one of the first members of the

Dime Box Volunteer Fire Department. He served as Assistant Fire Chief from 1968 through 1978 and was Fire Chief from 1979 through 1995. Erwin was a longtime member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas and served in many capacities such as trustee and on the stewardship board. His main pleasure was keeping the church property clean and repaired. Erwin's pride and joy was building and installing the flag pole, and was in charge of hanging the flags for many years. Erwin was called to his heavenly home on March 4, 2019 reaching the age of 88 years, 3 months and 22 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Martin & Clara Iselt; In-laws, John & Emma Symank and brother, Waldemar (Shorty) Iselt.

Erwin is survived by his loving wife of 66 years, Magdalena; sons and daughters-in-law, Wayne & Pam Iselt and Dan & Lisa Iselt of Lexington; 4 grandchildren, Kay & Caleb Latimer of Lexington, Kara & Cory Harris of Lexington, Stephen & Erica Iselt of Serbin, and Stephanie & TJ Klein of College Station; 7 great grandchildren, Owen Rhodus of Lexington, Cole & Cash Latimer of Lexington, Lukas & Cora Iselt of Serbin, and Brooklyn & Camryn Klein of College Station. Also survived by In-laws, Herman & Bernie Symank of Houston, Florence & Bob Wrigley of Austin, Hermine Iselt of Old Dime Box and numerous nieces and nephews.

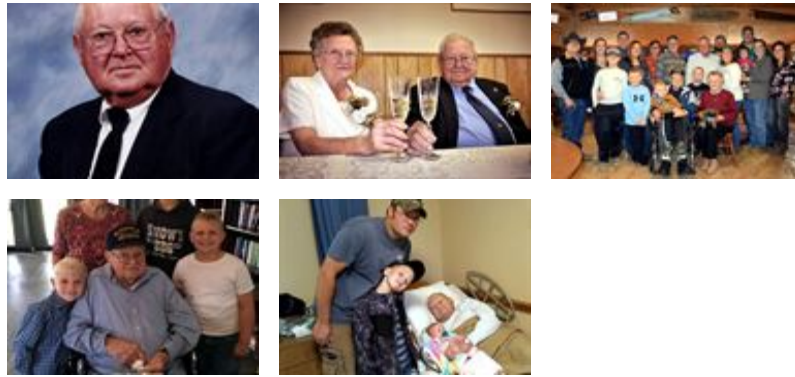
