



Erwin William Schulze

January 16, 1933 - July 8, 2015

Funeral services for Erwin William Schulze, 82 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, July 13, 2015 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, July 11, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., on Sunday, July 12, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Monday, July 13, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Schulze family will be present for visitation Sunday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Erwin William Schulze was born on January 16, 1933 in Loebau, Texas to Carl Wilhelm Schulze and Hulda Dora (Sanders) Schulze. He was baptized on January 17, 1933 at Christ Lutheran Church in Loebau by Rev. Carl Durow and was confirmed on March 30, 1947 at Christ Lutheran Church by Rev. Herbert Hartfield. His confirmation verse was 1 Timothy 1:15, "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief." Erwin was united in marriage to Florine Meyer on June 2, 1956 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Fred Mgebroff. Their union was blessed with two children, Carolyn and Steven. Erwin & Florine moved to Houston shortly after their marriage where Erwin was employed as a sheetrocker before working as a security guard with Humble Oil Company. Eventually, Erwin & Florine both went to work as custodians with Spring I.S.D. They moved back to Giddings in 1982 and Erwin

went to work in the maintenance department at the Lee County Courthouse. He worked for Lee County for nearly 13 years when he retired in 1995. Erwin also served as the custodian part-time for the Lee County Appraisal District for 23 years, Bobby Lehmann Trucking for 15 years and Newman & Keng Paving for several years. He was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings, the Sons of Herman Lodge #151 in Round Top and a supporter of the Lee County Junior Livestock Show. Erwin enjoyed working with his cattle, chickens, gardening, hunting, fishing, and cooking outdoors for family gatherings. He and Florine enjoyed taking care of children in their home for 32 years. They became "Grandpa & Grandma Schulze" to each of the one's they kept and they would all pile on his lap at the same time when he got home from work.

Erwin passed away the afternoon of Wednesday, July 8, 2015 at the Giddings Residence and Rehabilitation Center surrounded by his family.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Carl & Hulda Schulze; his son, Steven "Bluebell" Schulze; his parents-in-law, Alwen & Mary Meyer; his brother and sister-in-law, Alfred & Lydia Schulze; his sister and brother-in-law, Amanda & Fritz Schroeder and his brother-in-law, Bob Dobbler.

Erwin is survived by his wife of 59 years, Florine Schulze of Giddings; his daughter and son-in-law, Carolyn & Larry Wachsmann of Lincoln; two grandchildren, Stephanie Winkelmann & husband, Ryan of Burton and Randy Wachsmann & fiancée, Megan Maass of Lincoln; two great grandchildren, Dalton & Mallory Winkelmann of Burton; two sisters, Gertrude Dobbler of Derby, Kansas and Esther Urban of Giddings; three brothers, Herbert Schulze & wife, Lorine of Houston, Lawrence Schulze & wife, Terry of Houston and Leroy Schulze & wife, Myrna of Garland; brother-in-law, Otis Meyer & wife, Doris of Giddings as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
