



## Erwin Theodore Zoch

Erwin Theodore Zoch was born on June 21, 1923 in Winchester, Texas to Carl Emil and Lydia Louise (Kasper) Zoch. He married Alice Ruth Elizabeth Dunk on September 22, 1946 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, their union blessed with 5 children.
