



Eugene Charles Iselt

October 6, 1944 - February 2, 2022

Eugene Iselt was born on October 6, 1944 in Loebau, Texas to Gustav and Olga (Beisert) Iselt. quing and playing the guitar and singing. In his younger years he played with
the Blue Notes Band. Eugene also like going to the beach, visiting with his

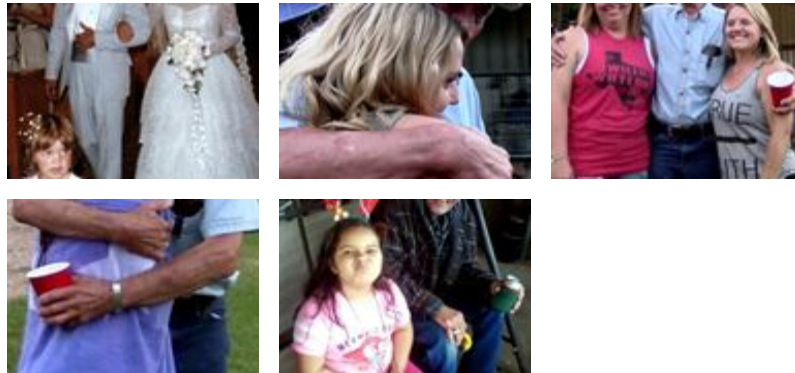
