



Evelyn Marvene Barrow

September 22, 1920 - May 2, 2009

Evelyn Marvene Barrow was born September 22, 1920 in Turkey, Texas and is the oldest of 5 children born to Marvin (Judge) and Dee Nall. Marvene moved to Floyd, New Mexico at the young age of 9 months when her parents headed for Colorado in a covered wagon but stopped near Portales and settled there. Upon graduation from Floyd High School, she went to Plainview, TX to attend Lippert's Business School. She also worked at the Barrow Tea Room where she met and married Donald Boone Barrow on her birthday in 1940. They were married 59 1/2 years before his death in 2000. She was a homemaker most of her life. Don and Marvene raised their sons in Floydada from 1952 to 1968. In 1968 they moved from Floydada to become co-managers of Christian Church Camps in Center Point and Lake Brownwood. They retired from Lake Brownwood Christian Retreat in 1987. Upon retirement, they moved to Rockdale, TX to be closer to Frank and Pat and their two grandsons. Don and Marvene were active in the First Christian Church in Rockdale as well as volunteers for Meals on Wheels for several years. Marvene moved to Glen Rose in 2002 when Frank and Pat moved there. She enjoyed her time in Glen Rose, the First United Methodist Church, the Senior Citizens Center where she like to play 42, and all the many helpful friends that made this move easier. Marvene has resided at Cherokee Rose Manor in Glen Rose since 2006. Marvene passed away May 2, 2009 in Glen Rose, Texas. She reached the age of 88 years, 7 months and 10 days. She was preceded in death by her husband Donald Boone Barrow, her son James

Richard Barrow in 1967, her parents, a brother Mark Nall and a sister, Linnie Borden. Survivors include a son, Frank Barrow and wife Pat of Glen Rose. She has two grandsons, Boone and Tim. Boone Barrow and wife Cathy of College Station have 5 daughters, Gracie, Gretchen, Emma, Madeline, and Sarah. Tim Barrow and wife Daniela of Chino Hills, CA have 2 sons, Tristan and Dylan. Her sisters, Doris Dobbs and Katherine Smith, both of Floyd, NM along with her brother's wife, Bobbie Nall of Portales and numerous nieces and nephews also survive.
