



Evelyn Olga Loewe

February 25, 1933 - June 20, 2025

Funeral services for Evelyn Loewe, 92, of Ledbetter will be held 10:00 am, Tuesday, June 24, 2025 at St. John Lutheran Church in Dime Box with Rev. Terry Bage officiating. Visitation will be held Monday, June 23, from 11:00 am until 8:00 pm and on Tuesday from 7:00 am until 8:00 am at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings with the family present on Monday from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm. Burial will follow at the Loewe Family Cemetery in Carmine.

Evelyn Loewe, 92, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Friday, June 20, 2025. She was born on February 25, 1933, in a farmhouse in the Burton area to Albert and Clara Mueller. The Muellers had four daughters, with Evelyn being the youngest. She was lovingly referred to by her siblings as “Baby,” and eventually nieces and nephews would call her “Aunt Baby.”

She was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Rehberg and later confirmed at Burton Lutheran Church. Growing up, her parents instilled a strong work ethic in Evelyn and her sisters. One of her first jobs was helping her mother chop cotton in the fields. She later worked in the kitchen at Blinn College as a server. Evelyn stopped going to school at a young age to help her father with his milk route. Later in life, when she was asked what her hobbies were, she simply replied “Work” and that is something she did her entire life.

One of Evelyn’s favorite pastimes was being around family and dancing. In 1949, she tagged along with her oldest sister, Benita, and her husband, R.C.,

to R.C.'s cousin, Lawrence "L.A." Loewe's house for a dance. Lawrence ended up driving Evelyn home, and then later he wrote her a letter asking her to go on a date with him. Lawrence would become her husband on October 23, 1949, after knowing each other for just four short months.

They bought a farm and started their life together. On that farm, they lived, loved, labored, and danced their way through 59 years of marriage. In 1952, they were blessed with the birth of their first daughter, Carolyn, and two years later, they welcomed their second daughter, Linda.

In 1970, Evelyn turned one of her favorite pastimes into a career by becoming the cafeteria manager at Dime Box ISD, cooking for students and faculty. She worked there for 25 years, retiring in 1995. During her time there, she made lasting friendships that she continued to cherish. After retirement, Evelyn returned to helping around the ranch, processing meat, and eventually caring for her husband as his health declined. Of all the chores she had on the ranch, her favorite was cleaning pecans from their pecan grove. During pecan season, you could find her with her card table set up in the kitchen, two buckets- one for pecan halves, one for pieces- and a flat of pecans.

Another joy in Evelyn's life was traveling with Lawrence and their friends. After each trip, she would create a photo album, with every photo labeled in detail. One special memento they collected from each trip was a shot glass. These glasses were proudly displayed in her home and admired by grandchildren and great-grandchildren, who even contributed to her collection from their own travels. There were easily over 40 different shot glasses in her home -a sign of a lifetime of cherished memories.

What brought Evelyn the most joy, however, were her grandchildren. Her daughters gave her and Lawrence seven grandchildren; six grandsons and one granddaughter. At that point, Evelyn earned a new title: "Granny." This

name was used not only by the grandkids and great-grandkids but also by all their friends.

The second greatest joy in her life was cooking and baking. Almost every Sunday, Granny made fried chicken -one of her personal favorites -but she always made sure to prepare side dishes that each grandchild loved. This simple meal quickly turned into a feast with many, many sides. This tradition continued for her great-grandchildren as well. Evelyn loved cooking for family and for anyone else who stopped by. She enjoyed trying new recipes, always following them exactly the first time, then noting in the cookbook how she would improve it next time. One of her most requested dishes was her coffee cake. And even if you got the recipe straight from Evelyn, yours never quite tasted like hers -because her secret ingredient was always love.

Evelyn was active in her church and community. She was a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Dime Box, the American Legion Post #276, and the Sons of Hermann. She and Lawrence were strong supporters of the Dime Box Volunteer Fire Department and the Lee County Junior Livestock Show. She enjoyed supporting good causes -whether by buying tickets or donating baked goods for auctions.

Although her passing is deeply felt by her family, they find comfort in knowing she is reunited with her loving husband, Lawrence; her parents, Albert and Clara Mueller; an infant brother; father & mother-in-law, Willie and Ida Loewe; son-in-law, Milroy "Fizzie" Guelker; her sisters & brothers-in-law, Benita and R.C. Loewe, Esther and Melvin Schultz, and Dora & Johnnie Braun; brother and sister-in-law, Melvin & Florine Loewe; her nieces & nephews, Raymond & Virginia Loewe, Ronnie Roemer, and Johnnie Wayne Braun.

Her family is certain she's now dancing a polka with Lawrence and baking in the grandest kitchen, one where the oven is always warm, nothing ever burns, and the kitchen is self-cleaning.

She was survived by her daughters, Carolyn Faske and husband Jerry of Bishop, and Linda Kieschnick and husband John of Giddings; grandchildren, Chris Kieschnick and wife Stephanie of Dime Box, Jeff Faske and wife Sarita of Bishop, James Faske and wife Katie of Bishop, Lorin Kieschnick and wife Jennifer of College Station, Walt Kieschnick and wife Megan of Katy, Wes Kieschnick of Giddings, and Abby Goehring and husband Matt of Navasota; 10 great grandchildren, Dilyn Kieschnick of Dime Box, Jack, Jeorge, Jacob, and Hailey Faske all of Bishop, Kaylynn, Claire, and Whitten of College Station, Madelyn and Walker of Katy as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Serving as pallbearers will be, Ricky Loewe, Randy Loewe, Rodney Loewe, Ryan Loewe, Joel Roemer, Jason Roemer, and Clifford Dawson.

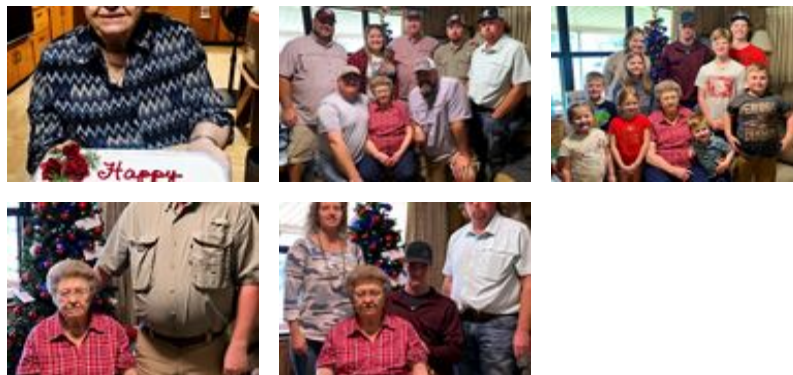
