Joyce continued bookkeeping for Key Auto and Truck Supply and Mitchell Tire Service until she retired in 2018.

She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church from 1991 to present, serving and enjoying the church family. She was part of Stone Soup and small groups and loved the church. Joyce moved to Burseson St. Joseph Manor in 2018 and received wonderful care by the staff and family until her death. Joyce was an avid reader, she loved playing games especially dominoes,
