Evelyn Janette Beard Young, 79, of Rockdale, died August 2, 2015. In accordance with her wishes, she will be cremated and there will be a Celebration of Life Reception at the Pleasant Retreat United Methodist Church, south of Thorndale, from 2-5 P.M. Sunday, August 9, 2015.

Evelyn was born October 4, 1935 to Ulric and Estelle Smith Beard in the Conoley Community south of Thorndale. She married Graham Young, Jr. on June 20, 1953 and to this union, three children were born. Evelyn was a nurse at Richards Memorial Hospital in Rockdale for 20 years. kindness and mercy. Nothing but love for my dear friend - Evelyn!

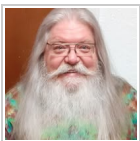
