



Finnie Mullins Jr

Graveside services for Finnie Mullins Jr., 66, of Lexington, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, October 12, 2020 at the Prospect Cemetery in Lexington with Ricky Spencer and Chris Bruce officiating. The family will be present for visitation from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Finnie Mullins Jr. was born on February 14, 1954 in Freeport, Texas to Finnie Mullins Sr. and Odie Lou (Cherry) Mullins. He was retired from Alcoa in Rockdale where he worked for 36 years, first in the pot room and then as a mechanic. When Alcoa went on strike in 1986, he earned his taxi driver's license and worked as a taxi driver in Austin during that time. He also owned The Daycare in Lexington for several years. Finnie was a member of the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department and served as the City of Lexington Fire Marshall for 33 years. He was also a member of the First Baptist Church in Lexington. Finnie always tried to help and take care of others which led him to become a licensed caregiver for the mentally disabled. He was always staying busy whether it was mowing grass, shredding, or feeding the cows. But he would never let anything interrupt his daily afternoon nap.

Finnie passed away the morning of Thursday, October 8, 2020 in an Austin hospital.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

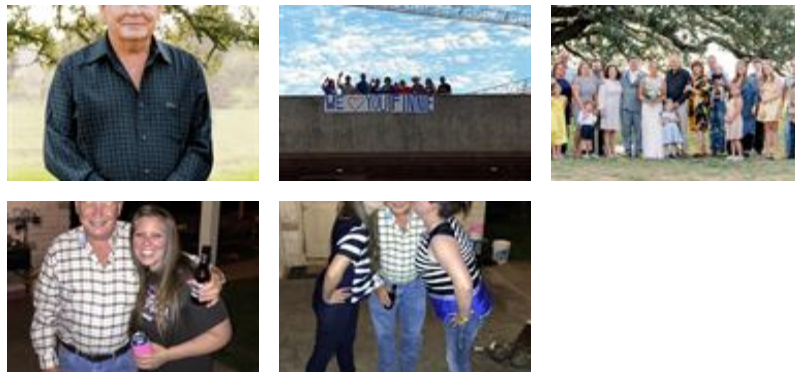
