



Frances "Grannie" Biehle

Frances "Grannie" Biehle was born July 24, 1918 in Austin to Joseph Karl and Tracy (Haag) Beran. On October 19, 1946 she and Adolph Robert Biehle were married. She was a lifelong resident of Thorndale and member of Pleasant Retreat United Methodist Church. Granny was a homemaker and was well known for the cookies she baked. Granny attended all the Thorndale sporting events with her grandchildren and great grandchildren, sitting on the bottom row so she could visit and hug all the kids. She was a big supporter of St. Paul Lutheran School and Thorndale High School.

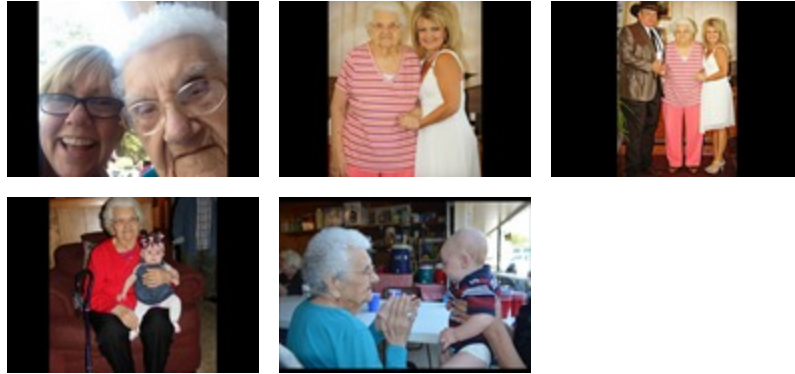
