Funeral services for Frances Bernice Iselt, 83 of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Monday, December 21, 2020 at the Christ Lutheran Church Parish Hall in Loebau, Texas with Rev. Frances Bernice Iselt was born on February 12, 1937 in Loebau, Texas to Paul Gerhard Schulze and Bertha Louise (Pampell) Schulze. She worked many years as a bookkeeper for the NAPA store in Giddings working alongside of Edmund. Bernice also worked at The Bridal Shop as a seamstress. She enjoyed going to market and seeing all the new bridal dresses. Bernice went everywhere Edmund went. Together they went to the ranch to feed the cattle and spent many weekends traveling to the coast in their RV to go fishing or just because

they wanted fresh shrimp. She loved working in her garden and tending to her flowers. Bernice was an active member of Christ Lutheran Church, member of the LWML, and volunteered for the Lutheran Braille Workers. She cherished her family and spent as much time with her greatgrandchildren that she could.

Frances passed away the afternoon of Friday, December 18, 2020 at Giddings Residence and Rehabilitation Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Paul and Bertha Schulze; husband, Edmund Iselt; brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Willie George Iselt and Joyce Iselt, and sister-in-law, Ellen Schulze.

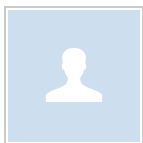

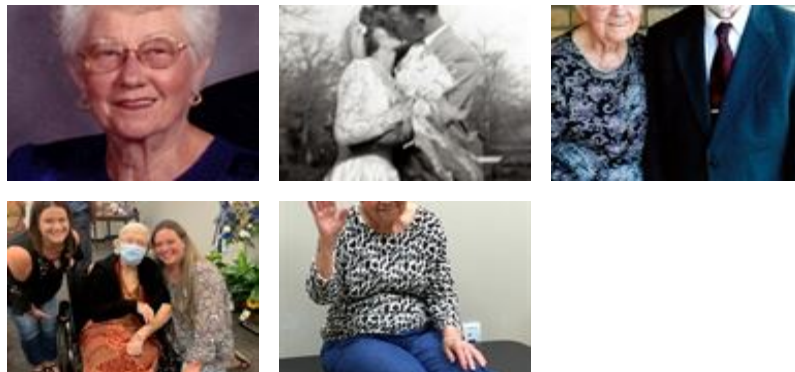
