Frances Evelyn (Zoch) Roeber, 85 of Serbin, was called home to her heavenly Father on July 16, 2021.

Frances was born at home in Greasy Bend, Winchester, TX on September 13, 1935. She was the sixth child of Herman J. and Lydia Symank Zoch. Frances was baptized on September 29, 1935, at St. Michael's Lutheran Church in Winchester by Pastor Louis Trinklein. The family moved to Giddings and she was confirmed in May of 1950 at Immanuel Lutheran Church. Frances attended Immanuel Lutheran School and was the Valedictorian of her 8th grade class. In 1954 she graduated Salutatorian from Giddings High School.

Soon after graduation she moved to Houston where she worked as a bookkeeper and receptionist for many years in various businesses. On July 28, 1956, Frances married Herbert Paul Roeber of Gonzales. She enjoyed 64 years of love and adventure with Herb, and the two were blessed with three children, Belinda, Phyllis, and Greg. They lived and worked in Houston until the late 70's when they built their forever home in Paige, TX.

In retirement, Frances enjoyed a multitude of hobbies that all focused on her family and her love of the Lord. Frances and Herb appreciated gardening for many years behind their home. They put up countless quarts of pickles and unknown amounts of peas. Frances used her talents as a seamstress to sew

numerous dresses for her beloved granddaughters. After mastering dresses, she moved on to crochet blankets for each of her grandchildren. As if that wasn't enough, she advanced her skill into counted cross-stitch, which she delighted in for as long as her hands would allow. Aside from sewing, Frances enjoyed other crafts and homemaking activities.

Outside of her homemaking abilities, Frances lived to serve the Lord. Every Sunday morning her pew was waiting for her. She honored Him by singing in the church choir for many years. For a period of time, she also served in the Lutheran Women's Missionary League and enjoyed making quilts for the church's annual fundraiser. The church was Frances' home away from home.

Amid her kind-hearted and loving nature, Frances also had a competitive spirit. For many years she cherished playing dominoes, from chicken foot to 42. Occasionally she would venture to the Sons of Herman for a night of Bingo. In her later years, it was the daily competition with her neighbor to see who could solve the Jumble first.

Frances loved any opportunity to gather with family and friends. Friday nights were for meeting up at Northrup Store and having a beer with close friends before going to dinner with Herb. Weekends and holidays were always reserved for her children and grandchildren. To Frances, anytime was a good time to be with the people she loved. Next to having three wonderful children, her greatest joy came from her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Frances treasured being "Granny."

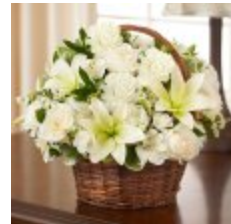

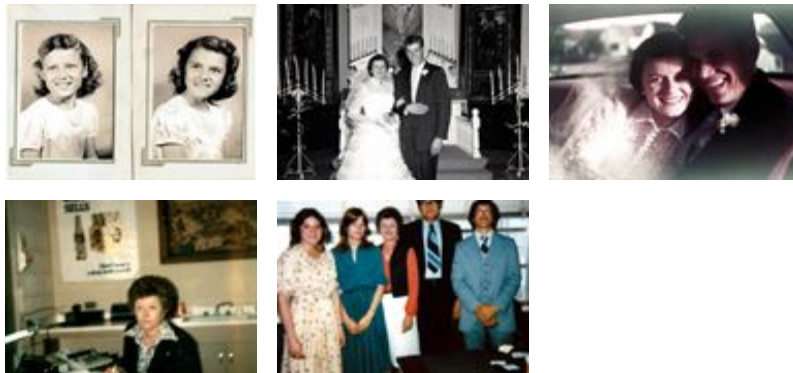
