



## Frances Marie Zoch

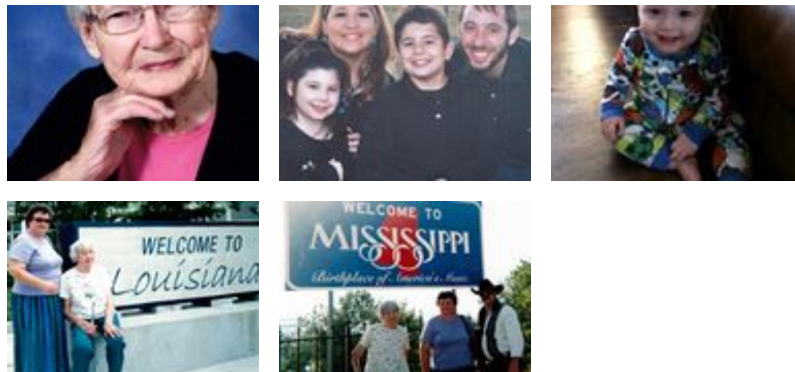
