Frank Ramirez, Jr., age 53 of Austin, formerly of Rockdale, passed away Monday, November 25, 2019 at St. David's Hospital in Round Rock.

Mass will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday, November 30, 2019 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Rockdale with Rev. Pedro Castillo officiating. Burial in San Jose Cemetery in Hearne, Texas. Visitation is 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with a Rosary at 7:00 p.m. Friday, November 29th, at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale.

Frank, Jr. was born April 12, 1966 in Hearne to Frank and Lydia (Barrera) Ramirez. He was a 1984 graduate of Rockdale High School. He attended Sam Houston State University until he was drafted by the Atlanta Braves and played for two seasons. He moved to Round Rock and earned an Associate Degree with Southwestern School of Electronics. He began his career as a software technician engineer with Alcoa in Rockdale as a Supervisor, Polycom, Hewlett-Packard and currently at Brillo.

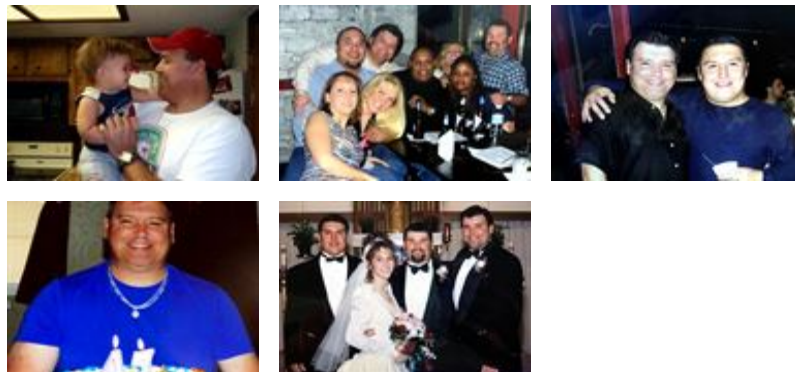
