Frederick Carter Newton, Sr. was born on Sept. 11, 1924 in Rockdale and was a son of James Oscar Newton & Annie (Rumple) Newton. He and Patricia McBride were married on June 3, 1945 in Houston and to this union three children were born. He graduated from Rockdale High School in 1942 as Valedictorian and class President, then entered Texas A&M. In 1943 he was called into active duty and received his wings and commission in the Air Corp, then flew 35 missions over Germany. He retired from the Air Force after 31 years with the rank of Colonel. Frederick then retired after 20 years from Global Marine Drilling Co. as a Senior Vice President of Sales and Contracts. He was preceded in death by his parents; Infant son and daughter, Lawrence R. & Malinda A. Newton; Two brothers, Howell & Charles "Tip" Newton. Frederick passed away Tuesday, Aug. 31, 2010 in Houston having reached the age of 85. Survivors include his wife, Pat of Houston, Two sons: Carter Newton Jr. "Rick" of Tuscon, AZ and Steve Newton of Houston. A daughter, Kimberly Newton of Los Angeles, CA.
