Garland Stanley, 77, of Milano, passed away Saturday, January 20, 2018 in Temple. In accordance with his wishes, he was cremated. Memorial services will be held from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday, April 21, 2018, at the Milano Civic Center with Military Honors rendered at 12:30 pm.
