



Gary Leroy Kimey

January 22, 1946 - November 19, 2014

Gary Leroy Kimey was born on January 22, 1946 in Houston, Texas to Milton Leroy Kimey & Shirley P. (Dunn) Kimey. He graduated from Giddings High School and served in the U.S. Air Force from January 10, 1966 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on August 21, 1969. He obtained the rank of Sergeant. Gary also served an additional four years in the U.S. Air Force Reserves. He had been employed at the Giddings State School and also worked as a salesman and did small engine repair work. He had obtained his pilot's license and enjoyed flying when he was younger. He was happiest when he was working on and riding his motorcycle and when he was spending time visiting with his friends. Gary passed away unexpectedly the evening of Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at his home in Paige.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Sherwood Kimey.

Gary is survived by his four children, Chris Kimey & his girlfriend, Miranda Ackerman of Paige, Misty Roberts-Guenther & her husband, Matthew of
