Geneva D. Kennedy, age 94 of Arlington and formerly of Rockdale, passed away Monday morning, May 18, 2020 at Avalon Memory Care in Arlington. Memorial services will be held 1:00 p.m. Saturday, June 27, 2020 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Rockdale. Burial will follow at Walkers Creek Cemetery near Cameron, Texas.

Mrs. Kennedy was born April 29, 1926 in Whitesboro, Texas to Henry and Serena (Boaz) Dutton. She was a graduate of Wilson N. Jones School of Nursing in Sherman, Texas.
