Geneva Kornegay Young, born February 15, 1930 in Milam County, Texas passed away peacefully May 28, 2015 with her family by her side in Cameron, Texas after a long bout with Alzheimer's disease.

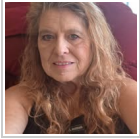

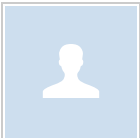

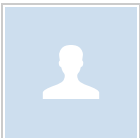
