He served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean Conflict and obtained the rank of Private First Class. George was united in marriage to Dorothy Frosch on June 17, 1956 at the Lexington United Methodist Church in Lexington. He was a plumber who trained many plumber helpers through the years who eventually obtained their plumbing licenses. After retiring from the plumbing business, George enjoyed farming and ranching and also did custom hay bailing. He was a longtime member of Faith Lutheran Church in McDade where he had served as President of the congregation and was instrumental in the construction of the present sanctuary and sunday school building. He was currently a member of New Hope Lutheran Church in McDade. George was also a lifetime member of the VFW Post 8313 in McDade where he had

served as Commander and Quartermaster for many years. He was a member of the McDade Watermelon Festival Association and helped barbeque for the event for many years. He also served as a driver for the McDade Watermelon Festival parade float. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edd & Willie Moore and a brother, Wilburn "Curly" Moore.
