George William Pohorelsky, lovingly known as Sonny Boy and Popo, was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather whose life was defined by hard work, integrity, and an unwavering love for his family.

For 62 beautiful years, he cherished and adored his beloved wife, Jane. Together, they built a life rooted in faith, family, and the enduring values he carried so proudly.

A lifelong resident of Lee County, George was born, raised, and spent his entire life there. He graduated from Giddings High School in 1959 and remained deeply connected to the community he loved. He was a faithful, longtime member of Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings, Texas, where his quiet strength and steady presence reflected the depth of his faith.

George was a proud and dedicated father to his two sons, Steven and David. Some of his greatest joys were found on the baseball field, coaching their Pee Wee teams and guiding not only his boys, but so many others. Coaching was far more than a pastime—it was one of his greatest pleasures. When he wasn't coaching, he could often be found behind home plate, serving as an umpire with fairness and good humor.

A true outdoorsman, George felt most at peace in nature. He loved hunting, fishing, camping, gardening, and tending cattle. The small family farm in Lincoln held a special place in his heart. There, he would often sit quietly by the tank, reflecting on life as he looked out over the water. An avid animal lover, he was never without a beloved fur baby faithfully by his side.

George devoted nearly 40 years of dedicated service to Bluebonnet Electric Cooperative, retiring in 2001. His career was marked by commitment, honor, and a tireless work ethic. Beyond his professional life, he generously gave his time to the Lee County Livestock Show, faithfully assisting in the sales ring and helping raise funds to support the youth of Lee County. Encouraging and investing in young people involved in agriculture was something he deeply believed in.

George never met a stranger. A gentle giant, he was known for his warm smile, steady handshake, and genuine kindness. Above all else, he was a family man. His love never wavered, and he always ensured his family felt cared for, supported, and deeply loved.

George passed away during the early morning hours of Tuesday, March 3, 2026, surrounded by his family, at Towers Nursing Home in Smithville.

He was preceded in death by his father, George; his mother, Martha (Gerlach); and his two sisters, Rose Pohorelsky and Betty (Peschke-Duke).

He is survived by his loving wife, Jane (Marburger); his sons, Steven and wife Christi, and David and wife Hope; his grandchildren, Colter Pohorelsky and wife Paige, Kyle Pohorelsky, Ashley Perez and husband Paul, and Reagan Sinclair and husband Luke; his great-grandchildren, Rowdy Pohorelsky, Townes and Whitley Perez, and Sadie Sinclair; his brother, Charles; and many nieces and nephews.

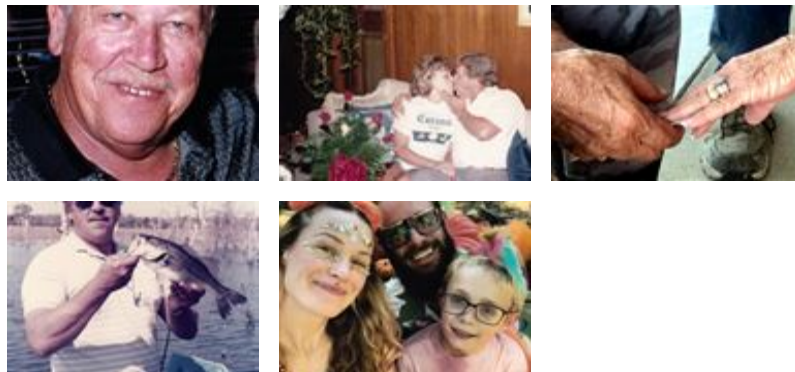
