“ When I was 19, I worked in Mr. Marburger's County Clerk's office, along with the late Joyce Hamff. We could always hear Mr. Spacek coming into the courthouse as his big, boisterous laugh thundered through that old building. Our office was terribly small with all the dockets we had so having a big, tall man like George Spacek try to get to whatever docket he needed was cumbersome! He thought it was funny for us to try to accommodate him. He'd keep us laughing while in there, never minding we had work to do. After he left the office, we talked about that laugh that kept us smiling the rest of the day. Decades later, when my mother was placed at Bec's Blessing & I saw Mr. Spacek there as a resident himself, I couldn't help but recall those days of that tiny office with the presence of this enormous, boisterous and friendly man. His body wasn't what it used to be but that laugh and smile were STILL there. Last Halloween, when the residents handed out treats at Bec's new facility, Mr. Spacek participated as well as he could. And with his children singing, his enthusiasm was very heavily felt in that room. May we always have that spirit for LIFE and LOVE of family that George Spacek had till the very end. My heart truly aches for you.
