



## George Douglas "Doug" Winters

November 16, 1928 - January 28, 2023

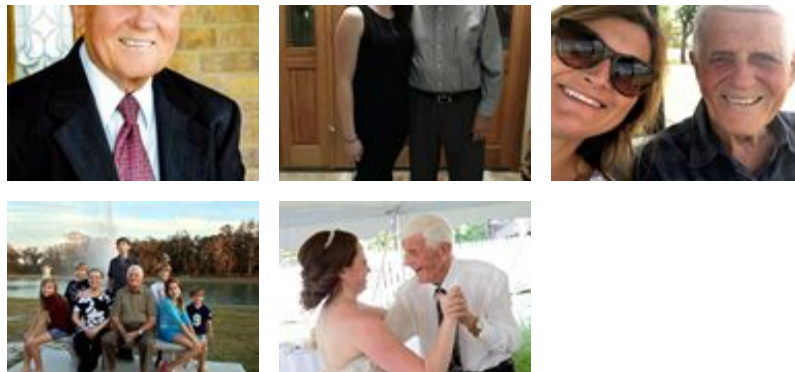
