Douglas Geraldine (Gerry) Offield, 94, of Rockdale, passed away peacefully on July 14, 2025, surrounded by her loving family. Born in Rockdale to Lida and A.A. Tuma, Gerry lived a life filled with kindness, dedication, and a passion for community.

Gerry graduated from Rockdale High School. She spent many years working for multiple companies as she lived in many cities and towns around America. She retired after many years working at the FHA as a supervisor of the Valley District approving loans for the farmers.

Gerry loved to travel and visited all 50 of the United States as well as Canada, Mexico, Europe and Great Britain.

She was very active in Rockdale. Elected to two terms on the City Council, serving on the Hospital Board, the Friends of the Library, and the Rockdale Historic Preservation Commission that restored the original train station and got it certified as an historical site.

Gerry was very active in the Democratic Party on a Local, State, and National

level. She was proud to be a delegate to the State and National conventions.

She is survived by her son, George Thomas Fuquay; his wife, Chaille and her granddaughter, Cecilia Christine Fuquay and her partner, Amanda Huss. She was preceded in death by her husband, Ray Gilbert Offield; her parents and her siblings.
