



Gilbert Danly Schulze

February 21, 1937 - March 12, 2023

Funeral services for Gilbert Schulze, 86 of Fedor, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, March 17, 2023 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas with Rev. Dale Bohm officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Thursday, March 16, 2023 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Friday, March 17, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Thursday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Gilbert Danly Schulze was born on February 21, 1937 in Fedor, Texas, the son of Daniel Jacob Schulze Sr. and Lydia Martha (Weiser) Schulze. He was baptized on March 7, 1937 and confirmed on April 6, 1952 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor. His confirmation verse was Revelation 3:11, "Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown." On April 1, 1957, he enlisted in the United States Army and served as a Morse Interceptor. He received his Honorable Discharge on March 1 1960, having obtained the rank of SP5. Gilbert was united in marriage to Eleen Edna Kalmbach on July 3, 1960 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor with Rev. August Horn officiating. He was a lifelong farmer and rancher. Gilbert served as the ranch manager for Red Gate Farm, which later became Schettler Ranch, for over 40 years. He also was a rural mail carrier for the U.S. Postal Service for many years. Gilbert's faith was always an important part of his life and throughout the years he was an active

member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings, and currently St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln. While a member at Immanuel, he taught Sunday school, served as an elder, and was a member of the school board. With Gilbert, every day was about work and what needed to be done. Just like an artist has a canvas, the land was the means with which Gilbert expressed his talent. He was meticulous and detailed in taking care of the part of God's creation that he was given the task to maintain. He took great pride in everything he did and was careful in taking care of things so that they lasted long beyond their normal useful life. When not working, he enjoyed jigsaw puzzles, shelling pecans, and an occasional peppermint.

Gilbert passed away the early afternoon of Sunday, March 12, 2023 in Bryan, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Daniel & Lydia Schulze Sr.; his wife of 61 years, Eleen Schulze; an infant son; three sisters, Amanda Wolf, Gertrude Hobratschk, and Anna Schmidt, and six brothers, Erwin, Edmund, Clarence, Roland, Raymond, and Marvin.

Gilbert is survived by his three children, Stephen & Susan Schulze of Bryan, Jennifer Couger of Fedor, and Amy & Michael Copeland of San Antonio; ten grandchildren, Adam & Analise Schulze of Bryan, Hannah & Stephen Howard of Bryan, Todd & Emma Schulze of College Station, William Schulze of Bryan, Jonah Couger of College Station, Jacob Couger of Lubbock, Maggie Couger of Fedor, Kylie Copeland of Houston, Claire Copeland of San Antonio, and Emma Copeland of San Antonio; five great grandchildren; one brother, Daniel & Ruby Schulze of Serbin; one sister-in-law, Diane Schulze of Kansas, as well as several in-laws, nieces, and nephews.
