



Gladys Mae Emma Arldt

July 15, 1935 - June 10, 2023

Funeral services for Gladys Arldt, 87, of Serbin, Texas are scheduled for 1:00 pm on Wednesday, June 14, 2023 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 from 10:00 am until 8:00 pm and on Wednesday, June 14, 2023 from 7:00 am until 11:00 am at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Tuesday evening from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Gladys Mae Emma (Mutschink) Arldt was born on July 15, 1935 in Giddings, Texas, the daughter of Richard and Wilhelmine (Witte) Mutschink. She was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings on August 4, 1935 by Rev. G.W. Fischer and confirmed on April 2, 1950 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann. Her confirmation verse was Isaiah 43:1, "But now thus saith the Lord that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine." Gladys was united in marriage to Charles Edward Arldt on January 1, 1956 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Max Studtmann officiating. They were blessed with five children, Mary Ann, Raymond, Eunice, Janice and Mark. Gladys was a faithful member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin where she had served in the Ladies Aid and volunteered with and was a supporter of the Texas Wendish Heritage Society. Gladys was an excellent seamstress who also did crocheting and embroidery

work and various other crafts. She always had a big garden and spent many hours canning. She also enjoyed taking care of her cats.

Gladys passed away, surrounded by her family, on Saturday, June 10, 2023 at Oakland Manor Nursing Center in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Richard & Minnie (Witte) Mutschink; her husband of 64 years, Charles Arldt; her daughter, Eunice Arldt; her parents-in-law, Edward & Laura Arldt, and her brothers and sisters, Alvin & Emily Mutschink, Margrete & Leon Ahlhorn and Leroy Mutschink.

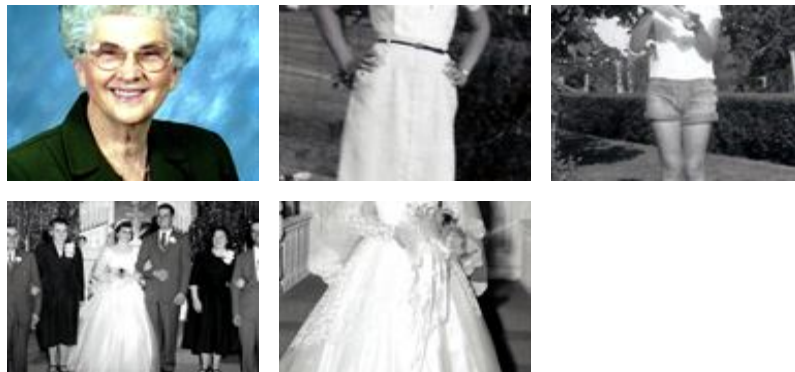

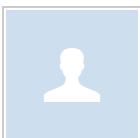
