



Gladys Patschke Jordan

November 11, 1940 - January 6, 2016

Funeral services for Gladys (Patschke) Jordan, 75 of Colorado Springs, Colorado, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 9, 2016 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, January 8, 2016 from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Saturday, January 9, 2016 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Gladys LaVerne (Patschke) Jordan was born on November 11, 1940 to Adolph & Erna (Dube) Patschke in their home near Fedor, Texas. She was baptized on November 17, 1940 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor by Rev. Adolph Michalk and confirmed on April 11, 1954 also at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church by Rev. Ludwig Karcher. Her confirmation verse was John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life". She attended grade school at Holy Trinity Lutheran School in Fedor and was the valedictorian of the 1958 class of Lexington High School in Lexington, Texas. She graduated in 1961 as a Registered Nurse from what is now Houston Baptist University and then married and began her favorite role: raising her six sons.

Gladys began her nursing career in Houston. She had an infectious joy and a notable giving and caring spirit. In 1976, she transitioned to occupational health nursing at large corporations such as Alcoa and Motorola. That career took her to Colorado Springs, Colorado, where she lived for 29 years. She loved the mountains and enjoyed hiking and gardening there. Gladys visited her children and their families often, and enjoyed singing "Happy Birthday" and "God's Blessings" to them over the telephone. Gladys was a strong Christian with unconditional love and daily prayers for family and friends. She discovered beauty everywhere and lived life to the fullest.

Gladys passed away the morning of Wednesday, January 6, 2016 in Dallas, Texas.

She was preceded in death by her father, Adolph Patschke.

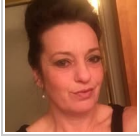
