



Gladys Schwarz Maass

December 25, 1927 - March 3, 2019

Funeral services for Gladys Maass, 91, of Giddings, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. John Waak officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, March 6, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Maass family will be present for visitation Tuesday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Gladys Schwarz was born on Christmas Day in 1927 in Round Top, Texas, the daughter of Emil Ernest Schwarz and Adala H. (Dippel) Schwarz. She was baptized on October 28, 1928 by Pastor J.H. Wendt and was confirmed on March 29, 1942 by Pastor Kralik. Gladys lost her mother one month before she turned 8 years old. She was raised by her father and sisters. Gladys enjoyed spending time at her father's store, shooting guns, and spending time outside at the farm. Gladys met Monroe Maass at a dance when she was 15 years old, and they married three years later on December 28, 1945 at Martin Luther Lutheran Church in Giddings. The two of them opened Maass Butane Company in 1964. They had two sons, Clyde and Ray, who would work alongside them with their wives at the family business. Monroe and Gladys enjoyed dancing and traveling. They also enjoyed going to rodeos with their sons. Gladys will be remembered by many as beautiful, classy, and full of grace. She was a loving wife, mother, grandma, and friend.

Gladys passed away the evening of Sunday, March 3, 2019 at Bec's Blessing in Giddings.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Emil & Adala Schwarz; her husband, Monroe Maass; her brother, Hilmer Schwarz & his wife Eunice; her two sisters, Lila Meyer & her husband, Arnold and Lela Sullivan & her husband, John; sisters-in-law, Mildred Berger & her husband, Elfred, Doris Maass, Lucille Goerlitz & her husband, Bill and Olefia Saegert & her husband, Alvin and brothers-in-law, J.E.
