Glenn Dwayne Els was born on March 31, 1955, in Ledbetter, Texas to Frank Herman Els and Erna Ella (Stork) Els. After graduating from Giddings High School, he started working in the oilfield. Glenn came back to Ledbetter to start a business with his brother called E&E Dirt Construction. Together they worked the business for around 12 years. Glenn went on to hook up gas busters on local oil rigs for a short time. Finally, he worked as a ranch foreman doing all matters of ranch work including building fence, cutting hay, and working cattle. He was united in marriage to Pearly Stork Watts on November 5, 2005. In his spare time he enjoyed fishing, hunting, dominoes, and cards. He would tell stories of walking all the way from Ledbetter to Carmine and back with his dogs to chase down a coon. He played a variety of sports, but above all he loved spending time with family and friends. He taught his sons the value of hard work and how to work with what you had. Glenn would give you the shirt off his back if you needed it and didn't waste a second if he had a chance to poke fun at you.

Glenn passed away the morning of Thursday, March 26, 2026, at Baylor Scott and White in College Station.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Frank Herman and Erna Ella Els; wife Pearly Els; brothers, David Els, Billy Els and Bobby Els; and sisters, Shirley Hart and Peggy Simmang.
