



Gregory "Greg" Allen Kuhlmann

July 6, 1958 - February 17, 2015

Funeral services for Greg Kuhlmann, 56 of San Antonio and formerly of Giddings, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 22, 2015 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Giddings City Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, February 21, 2015 from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and on Sunday, February 22, 2015 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. The family will be present for visitation Saturday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Gregory Allen Kuhlmann was born on July 6, 1958 in Giddings, Texas to Brice Edward Kuhlmann and Lavine Mary (Jenke) Kuhlmann. He was baptized on July 20, 1958 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda, Texas by Rev. Herbert Hartfield and confirmed on May 21, 1972 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Mercedes, Texas by Rev. Roy E. Stoll. His confirmation verse was Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes". Greg graduated from Bishop High School in 1976 and attended TSTI in Waco. He was united in marriage to Georgia Hewett on July 4, 1997 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas by Rev. Paul Hartfield. Greg worked as a mechanic for many years having been employed with Bob Gold Chevrolet and A.J.'s Paint and Body in Giddings and Tegeler Toyota and Appel Ford in Brenham. After moving to San Antonio, he worked for Tandy Leather Factory and at O'Reilly's Auto Parts. Greg was a member of Concordia Lutheran Church in San Antonio where he

had helped with the Fall Festival and drive thru nativity scene for several years. He was the type of person who was always willing to lend a helping hand. He enjoyed working on cars and was a fan of classic cars and especially Mopar muscle cars. Lately, Greg's hobby was wood lathing and he enjoyed using this hobby to make gifts for family and friends. He was a man who loved his family and was especially proud of his children and grandchildren. Greg passed away the evening of Tuesday, February 17, 2015 at the Christus Santa Rosa Hospital-Westover Hills in San Antonio.

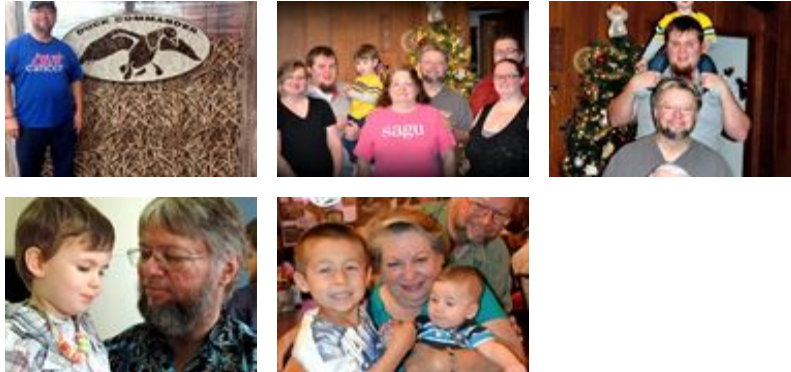

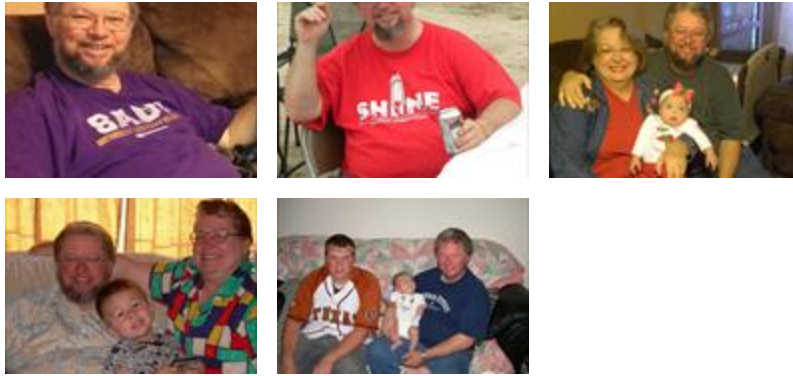
