



Gregory Dale Langehennig

Funeral services for Greg Langehennig, 58, of Lexington, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Monday, July 23, 2018 at the Lexington United Methodist Church in Lexington with Rev. Reagan Seaton officiating. Burial will follow in the Lexington Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday, July 22, 2018 from 12:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Monday, July 23, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Lexington. Gregory Dale Langehennig was born on April 21, 1960 in Giddings, Texas to Kermit William Langehennig and Billie Ann (Fricke) Langehennig. He was baptized and became a member of the Lexington United Methodist Church on April 11, 1976. Greg graduated from Lexington High School in 1979 and attended Blinn College in Brenham. He owned and operated Greg's Exxon in Lexington for many years. He married Gail Hobbs on April 25, 1992 at the Lexington United Methodist Church. Greg served several terms as a councilman on the Lexington City Council and was the animal control officer in Lexington for several years. He enjoyed fishing and tending to his cattle. Greg took Christmas decorating to the extreme and the lighted Christmas displays in his yard and at the station were legendary in Lexington. He had a heart of gold and would do anything that anyone asked of him.

Greg enjoyed taking his children on camping trips, fishing and trips to the lake. He always made sure that Christmas morning was special for his kids. In recent years, he and Kaleigh enjoyed their dad and daughter day trips to Austin. He loved being around children, teaching most of his nieces and nephews how to drive, and the last several years of his life totally revolved around his grandchildren. An example would be how Greg and his grandson, Rhyder, always told each other "you are my best friend". His grandkids were the light of his life and he enjoyed nothing more than taking them to school and being there for them and with them. Paw Paw and his grandkids brought the loud out in the house with all their Nerf gun wars and dragging Paw Paw around the house to look at this and that. They always knew that he would take them for ice cream and special treats. Greg always made the most of the simple things in life.

Greg passed away unexpectedly at his home the afternoon of Thursday, July 19, 2018.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Billie Langehennig; his brother, Jeffrey Langehennig; his brother-in-law, Travis Robertson and his father-in-law, Wesley Hobbs.

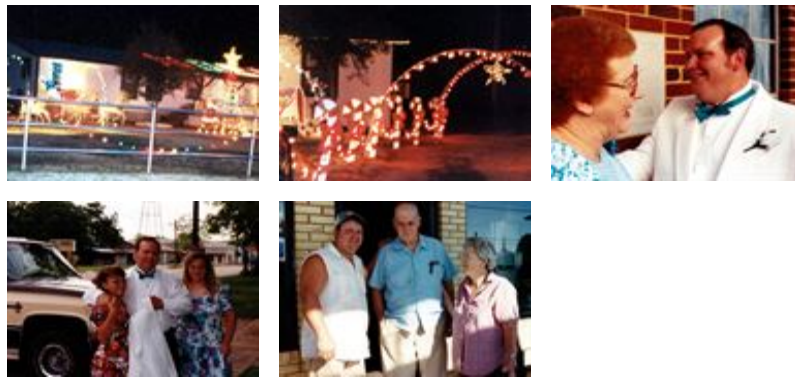

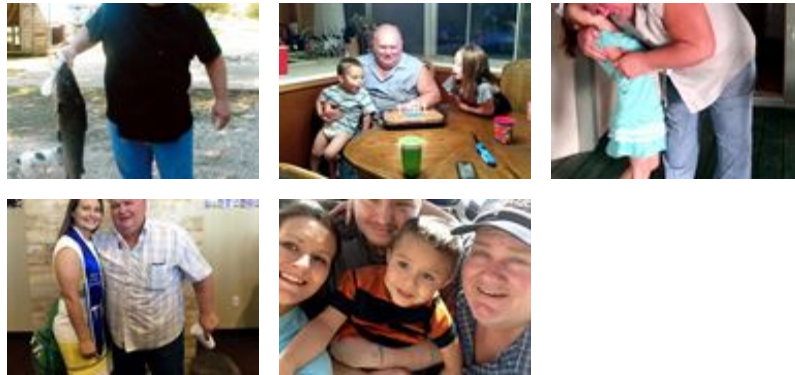
