



Guadalupe "Wallace" Rosas

Guadalupe 'Wallace' Rosas, 79, passed away Thursday, April 26, 2018 in Bryan, Texas. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 2pm on Tuesday, May 1, 2018 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Caldwell, Texas. Reverend Jesse Martinez and Reverend Bernard Hung will preside over services. Burial will follow at St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery. Visitation will be at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home on Monday, April 30, 2018 from 5 to 7pm with Rosary at 7pm.

Guadalupe was born in Caldwell on July 22, 1938 to Guadalupe and Mariana (Rios) Rosas. In October 26, 1973 he married Elsie Wemmert Love. Elsie passed away on February 8, 2002. On December 31, 2006 Wallace married again to Pam Schoenemann.

Wallace was a special man. His greatest gift was to make people laugh. He was the type of person that you would want to call in the time of need. He was always there for you. Wallace never met a stranger and spoke to everyone. He loved to play pranks on family and friends and to him life was one big party. He lived his life to the fullest.

Wallace enjoyed playing sports as well as watching them. Football was his favorite and he was Caldwell Hornet's #1 fan. He was at the games rain or shine; in his favorite spot at the top of the bleachers where he could 'coach.' He enjoyed going to the games with his 'buds', Phillip, Pat and Vance. He also

had another 'favorite' football game, Texas A & M Aggies and University of Texas Longhorns. Just so he could raz his family and friends.

Wallace served in the Army Nation Guard from April 1959 to March 1964. He worked at Alenco for several years. He retired from Alcoa in 1988 after 25 years of service. He was a Catholic by faith and a lifetime member of St. Mary's Catholic Church. He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus 3rd and 4th degree. He also enjoyed helping the Knights of Columbus with fund raising, including stacking wood, fish fries, and Barbecue, which he probably did more talking than working. They were also known to give a few nicknames such as Sheriff St. Mary's, Chief S. B., and Swivel Hips just to name a few. We will all miss his laugh, jokes and pranks.

Not only was he a good friend, brother, uncle, son-in-law and brother-in-law, he was a great Dad and Step-Dad. He will live in our hearts forever.

Preceding him in death were his parents, first wife Elsie; four brothers and three sisters; two brothers-in-law; and two sisters-in-law.

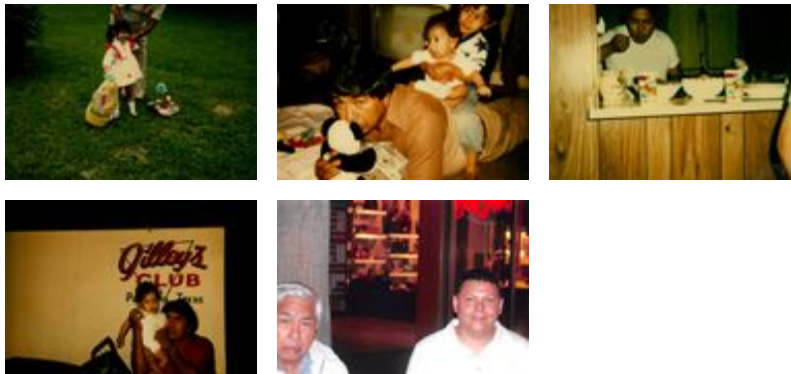
