



Gus Adolph Zoch

January 12, 1922 - November 7, 2013

Funeral services for Gus Zoch, 91, of Warda will be held Sunday, November 10, 2013, at 2:00 p.m. at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda, Texas. Gus Adolph Zoch was born January 12, 1922 in Warda, Texas to Carl E. Zoch and Anna Auguste (Hanusch) Zoch. Gus was baptized on January 22, 1922 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church by Rev. Gottfried Buchschacher and was confirmed on April 5, 1936 by Rev. Paul C. Eifert. His confirmation verse was Second Corinthians 12:9, "My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." Gus was a veteran of WWII, serving in the U.S. Army from November, 1942 through September, 1945. He married Irene Hedwig Vogel on December 30, 1945 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas. They were blessed with three children, Delbert, Delores, and Darlene. Gus was a farmer, and, in latter years, he became a carpenter and worked for M&M Lumber as well as Giese Construction.
