



Guy Bennie Hutson

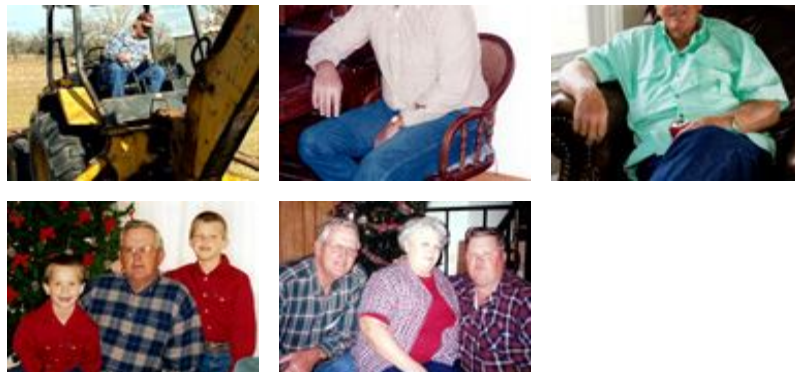

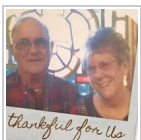
