Gwyndolyn passed away the morning of Thursday, August 27, 2020 at her brother's home in Paige with her family by her side.

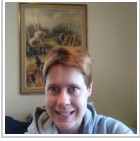
She is preceded in death by her parents, George Sr. & Paula Boswell.
