Mr. Davis was born February 8, 1920 in Elgin, Texas. He was the son of Thomas Houston and Maddie Adel (Stone) Davis. Mr. Davis served in the U.S. Marine Corps during WWII, He was on board the USS California when Pearl Harbor was attacked. After he received his Honorable Discharge in 1945 he and Babe Ruth Hadaway were married on April 29, 1946 in Houston. He worked for the U.S. Postal service, Special Delivery in Houston for 29 and a half years. After he retired in 1977 he and his wife moved to Bastrop where they lived for 17 years before making Rockdale there home for the past 16 years. Mr. Davis was a member of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association, The Taylor VFW and the Georgetown Marine League. Harold passed away Sunday morning December 19, 2010 at his home reaching the age of 90. He is preceded in death by his daughter, Gale Lawson, his parents, 3 brothers, Dale Davis, Violas Davis and Hal Davis and 2 sisters, Helen Barker and Ruby Rogas.
