Harold Houser was born January 13, 1929 in Scranton, Arkansas to Herbert Houser and Ada (Gilmore) Houser. He attended school in Arkansas and enlisted in the United States Marines on April 3, 1946. Harold was honorably discharged on January 12, 1948. He moved to Baytown, Texas in 1953. He went to work for Eastern States Oil and retired from Hill Oil Company January 1, 1991.
