He finally found the true glory he so much deserved and is now flying high on the wings of an eagle.

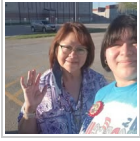
I'm sure he's up there, sharing wisdom and telling his adventure stories and jokes.

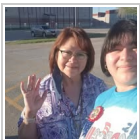
