

Harold Douglas "Doug" Miller

November 1, 1926 - March 12, 2023

Funeral services for Harold Douglas "Doug" Miller, 96 of Giddings, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 18, 2023 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings with Rev. Robert Tiner and Rev. Joshua Hahn officiating. Burial will follow in the Giddings City Cemetery with military honors provided by American Legion York Post #276. Visitation will be held on Friday, March 17, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, March 18, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Friday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Harold "Doug" Miller was born on November 1, 1926 in Faught, Texas, the son of John W. & Clara E. (Lassiter) Miller. Doug enlisted in the United States Navy on November 24, 1944 in Paris, TX and received his discharge on June 10, 1946 in Norman, OK. He served as a Machinist Mate during World War II. On July 4, 1950, Doug was united in marriage to Dorothy Lee Margaret Mutschink at St. John Lutheran Church in Truth or Consequences, NM by Rev. E.C. Ketter. He was baptized and confirmed on December 11, 1955 at St. Mark Lutheran Church in Waco by Rev. E.A. Heckmann. His confirmation verse was Revelation 2:10, "Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life."

Doug worked for Texas Power and Light for 30 years as a Lineman. After moving to Giddings, he worked for the City of Giddings Electrical Utility Department for 10 years. Doug and Dorothy were very active in their faith and helped start a mission church in Mineral Wells and also Peace Lutheran Church in Garland. They joined Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings where Doug served as a trustee and was quickly put in charge of ground maintenance. In his free time, Doug enjoyed fishing, taking care of his cattle, and tinkering with a new electrical project. Most of all, he loved spending time with his family.

Doug passed away the morning of Sunday, March 12, 2023 in Richmond, Texas.

He was preceded in death by his parents, John W. Miller & Clara E. Miller Cox; wife, Dorothy Lee Margaret Miller; brother, Xerxes Miller, and four sisters, Juanita Foster, Mary Carnel, Joyce Meredith, and Frankie Carney.

Doug is survived by his two sons, Rev. Chad Miller and his wife Darla of Richmond and Rev. Kirk Miller and his wife Tina of Colorado; six grandchildren, Rev. Galan Miller and wife Claudia of Rosenberg, Bree Galloway and husband Jordan of Sugar Land, Deidre Birge and husband Nathan of Richmond, Bethany Brenes and husband Riley of Alabama, Darsa Miller of Richmond, and Michal Miller of Houston; seven great grandchildren, Alyssa Galloway of Sugar Land, Riley Birge of Richmond, Townes Galloway of Sugar Land, Colt Birge of Richmond, Isabel Miller of Rosenberg, Odessa Brenes of Alabama, and Noak Brenes of Alabama, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family.

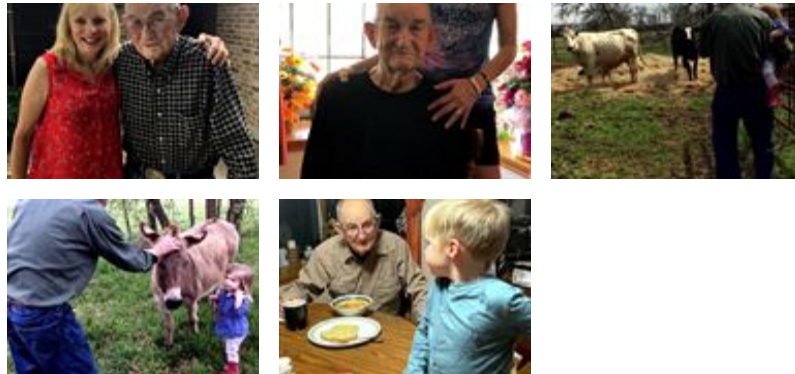

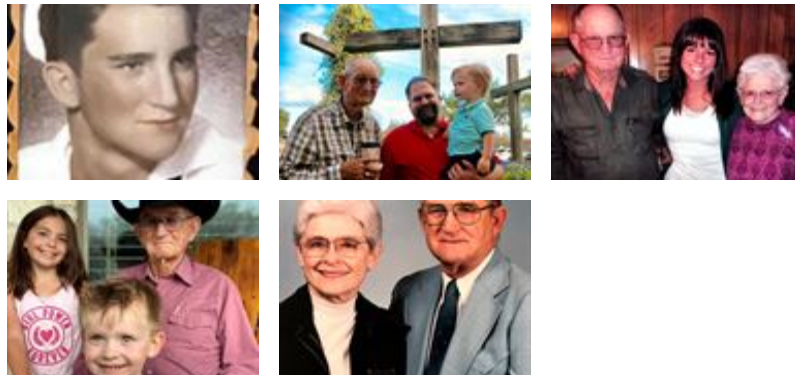
