



## Hattie Ella Mutschink

July 30, 1926 - October 5, 2021

Funeral services for Hattie Mutschink, 95 of Northrup, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 9, 2021 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Friday, October 8, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Saturday, October 9, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. Hattie Ella Mutschink was born on July 30, 1926 in Serbin, Texas to Alvin & Selma (Hohle) Mertink. On August 1, 1926, she was baptized at her family home by Rev. Herman Schmidt. She was confirmed on March 17, 1940 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin also by Rev. Herman Schmidt. Her confirmation verse was John 11:25,26," Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?" She went through 7th grade at St. Paul Lutheran School in Serbin. One of her earliest jobs was working for a family in Austin where she worked as a nanny, taking care of children, cooking meals, and helping with daily activities. On November 20, 1949, she was married to Johnny Mutschink at St. Paul Lutheran Church by Rev. C.H. Mutschink. They were

blessed with one daughter, Linda. Hattie loved working on the family land in Northrup, where she raised chickens, sold eggs to Serbin store and other local restaurants, and worked full time in her garden. When it came to her garden, there was a right way of doing things and was quick to let you know what it was. She also helped with catering for weddings and other celebrations. Hattie was known for her noodles and had made hundreds of pounds over the years. Hattie will be remembered as a faithful member of St. Paul Lutheran Church and a loving Granny to her family, grandchildren, and the community.

Hattie passed away the evening of Tuesday, October 5, 2021 at her home in Northrup.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Alvin & Selma Mertink; husband, Johnny Mutschink; sister and brother-in-law, Edna & Harold Noack; brother-in-law, Elbert Becker, and son-in-law, Jack Jones.

Hattie is survived by her daughter, Linda Jones of Northrup; two grandsons, Mark & Danielle Jones of Northrup and Scott & LeeAnn Jones of Northrup; four great-grandchildren, Rylee Smolik, Whitlee Smolik, Luke Jones, and Jocelyn Jones all of Northrup; sister, Adelia Becker of Serbin, and many nieces, nephews, extended family, and friends.

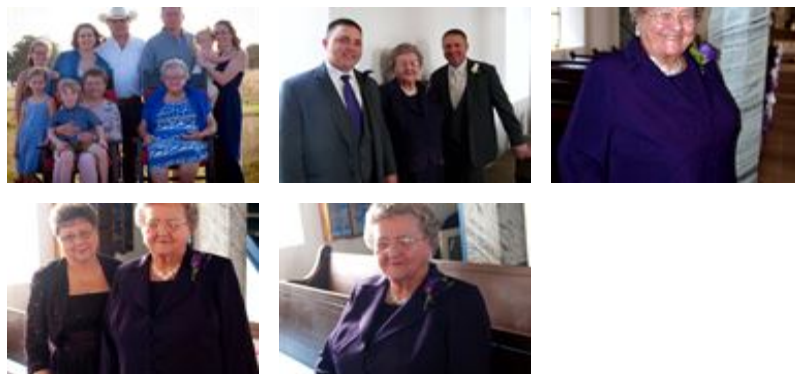
