



Hattie Louise Schautschick

November 17, 1926 - May 12, 2021

Funeral services for Hattie Schautschick, 94 of Serbin, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 20, 2021 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. The service will be livestreamed and can be viewed through the church's website at stpaulserbin.org. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, May 19, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, May 20, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present Wednesday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Hedwig "Hattie" Louise Schautschick was born on November 17, 1926 in Northrup, Texas to Johnnie T. and Marie Louise (Mertink) Mitschke. She was baptized on November 21, 1926 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt and confirmed on March 17, 1940 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda by Rev. Paul Eifert. Her confirmation verse was John 8:31-32, "Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free". Hattie was united in marriage to Herbert Walter Schautschick on December 29, 1946 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. Herman Schmidt officiating. Herbert & Hattie lived in Houston for many years where she had worked at Seandros Deodorant and as a seamstress at Bedspreads by Thomas. After moving back to Lee County in 1988, she went to work at Invader Boats in Giddings. Hattie was a talented

seamstress often making her children's clothing and did most of the sewing and alterations for the cheerleader uniforms and play costumes for Spring Branch ISD. She was a serious quilter and enjoyed gardening, especially her roses. Hattie could plant a stick and make it grow. She volunteered for many years with the USO and was a member of the Giddings American Legion Ladies Auxiliary. Hattie was known for her noodle making and through the years helped to make thousands of pounds of noodles at the Texas Wendish Heritage Museum. She was a faithful member of St. Paul Lutheran Church missing only a couple of services a year and made sure that her children attended as well.

Hattie passed away, surrounded by her children, the afternoon of Wednesday, May 12, 2021, at her home in Serbin.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Johnnie and Louise Mitschke; her husband, Herbert Schautschick; her sisters, Sophie Pampell, Hildegard Krause and her, husband Alfred and her brother, Vestin & Alma Mitschke.

Hattie is survived by her three children, Zelda & Russ Richards of Giddings, Kermit Schautschick of Giddings, and Herbert Jr. & Lora Schautschick of New Mexico; two grandchildren, Adam Richards of Dallas and Crystal Giddens of Leander; one brother-in-law, Marvin Pampell of Giddings, as well as several nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends.
