



## Hedwig (Hattie) Ruth Prellop

November 29, 1918 - August 2, 2014

Funeral services for Hedwig (Hattie) Ruth Prellop will be Tuesday, August 5, 2014, 10:00 A.M. at Trinity Lutheran Church, Fedor, Texas, with burial following in Trinity Lutheran Cemetery. Mrs. Prellop passed away on Saturday morning, August 2, 2014 at Giddings Residence & Rehabilitation Center in Giddings, Texas. Hedwig Ruth was born in Serbin, Texas on November 29, 1918 to Otto and Marie (Bohot) Driessner. She was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Serbin, Texas on December 8, 1918 by Rev. H.T. Kilian. Her confirmation was on March 20, 1932, also at St. Paul Lutheran Church, by Rev. Herman Schmidt. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 121:7-8, "7 The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. 8 The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore." Hattie was educated, through the eighth grade, in Serbin, at St. Paul Lutheran School.

Albert E. Prellop and she were united in marriage on November 26, 1939 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas. Their union was later blessed with their children, three daughters. Hattie was a homemaker who enjoyed baking, sewing (especially patchwork quilts), fishing, "garage sale-ing", playing dominoes and cards, and spending time with her grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Otto and Marie Driessner; her
