



## Helen Junell Schulz

November 14, 1935 - October 22, 2024

Funeral services for Junell Schulz, 88 of Serbin, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 27, 2024 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Saturday, October 26, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Sunday, October 27, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Saturday from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Helen Junell (Pietsch) Schulz was born on November 14, 1935 in La Grange, Texas, the daughter of Alfred and Minna (Walther) Pietsch. She was baptized on December 1, 1935 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda by Rev. Paul C. Eifert and confirmed on April 10, 1949 also at Holy Cross Lutheran Church by Rev. Eifert. Her confirmation verse was Psalm 118:24, "This is the day, which the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it." She attended grade school at Holy Cross Lutheran School in Warda and graduated from La Grange High School in 1953. Junell was united in marriage to Alfred Martin Schulz on November 1, 1954 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Warda by Rev. John L. Herzog. In 1958, their marriage was blessed with one son, David. Through David's marriage, her family came to include Carol.

Following Alfred and Junell's marriage, they moved to Angleton and became members at Grace Lutheran Church in Freeport. At Grace, she served her

Lord by being a Sunday school teacher. Junell was a very devoted and dedicated mother, who helped out at school functions and being there for all of David's school activities. After moving back to Serbin in 1982, Junell and Alfred attended St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin where she was a member of the Ladies Aid. She was also involved with taking tapes of the church services to the area nursing homes and homebound church members. Junell also enjoyed talking to relatives and friends by visiting them or by telephone. Her other hobbies included playing dominoes, taking care of her flowers around the yard, and helping Alfred with the ranching activities. Her greatest joy of all was her grandson, Christopher, whom she was so very proud of.

Junell passed away the afternoon of Tuesday, October 22, 2024 at Towers Nursing Home in Smithville.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Alfred and Minna Pietsch; her husband, Alfred M. Schulz; her brother and sister-in-law, Elmo and Helen Pietsch, and her brother-in-law, Walter Schumann.

Junell is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, David and Carol Schulz of Serbin; her grandson, Christopher Schulz of Serbin; one sister, Frances Schumann of Nechanitz; two sisters-in-law and one brother-in-law, Eleanor and Eugene Jenke of Lexington and Mildred Schulz of Cedar Park, along with many nieces, nephews, and friends.
