



Henry Ehrmann Mooney

September 7, 1946 - January 11, 2017

Henry Ehrmann Mooney, age 70, passed away January 11, 2017, following a lengthy battle with cancer. The family of Henry would like to invite family and friends to a visitation in Henry's honor at Hugh Wilson Cemetery on Saturday, January 21, 2017 from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm. Henry resided in Tanglewood, Texas most of his life. He was born in Cameron, Texas on September 7, 1946, to parents Henry E. Mooney and Evelyn Beard Mooney. Henry attended school in Spring Branch, a suburb of Houston, Texas. During his junior high and high school years Henry was active in the Boy Scouts of America, achieving many merit badges and awards.

After high school Henry moved to Tanglewood, Texas to work with his uncle, James Beard, raising cattle, farming watermelons and tomatoes, and preparing and shipping animal skins in the fur business. With the death of Henry's father in 1969, his mother returned to her childhood community in Tanglewood, Texas. Henry oversaw the construction of the home he and his brother built for her on the family homestead.

Henry raised cattle and farmed until he became disabled due to illness. For many years he was part of the Lexington Living Christmas Tree, an annual choral presentation of the Christmas story. Henry was an active member of the Lexington and later the Tanglewood Fire Departments.

He was preceded in death by both his parents, and his uncle, James Beard.

Henry is survived by his siblings, nieces and nephews, Carolyn Wright and her children, Jamie Wright and Renee Wright, and Renee's son, Maddox, all of Rockdale, Texas, Janna and her husband, Bobby Thomas of Dickinson, Texas, and their daughter, Michelle and her husband, Alisdair MacLean of Missouri City, Texas, and their children, Nicholas and Bridget MacLean; and son, Ryan and wife, Karen Thomas, and their son, Hank, of Austin, Texas, Fletcher Mooney of Tanglewood, Texas, Marsha Hembree of Abilene, Texas and her daughter, Courtnee Hembree of Midland, Texas.
