



Herbert Leon Medack

January 5, 1943 - May 28, 2018

Funeral services for Herbert "Leon" Medack, 75, of Lexington are scheduled for Saturday, June 2, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at St. James Lutheran Church in Lexington with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating.
