



Herman Theodore Gersch

December 21, 1930 - January 25, 2024

Funeral services for Herman Gersch, 93 of Northrup, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 30, 2024 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, Texas with Rev. John Schmidt officiating. The services will be livestreamed through the church's YouTube page which can be accessed through the church's website at stpaulserbin.org. Burial, with military honors provided by the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, will immediately follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, January 29, 2024 from 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, January 30, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Monday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Herman Theodore Gersch was born on December 21, 1930 in Northrup, Texas to Theodore Ernest Gersch and Olga (Steglich) Gersch. He was baptized on December 22, 1930 at his home in Northrup by Rev. Herman Schmidt and confirmed on April 1, 1944 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin by Rev. Herman Schmidt. His confirmation verse was 2 Timothy 2:8, "Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel." On October 23, 1952, Herman was united in marriage to Frances Louise Schatte at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Giddings by Rev. Max Studtmann.

Herman served in the United States Navy from April 7, 1952 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on April 6, 1960 having obtained the rank of Disbursing Clerk First Class. While in the Navy, they made their home in California. After his discharge, they moved to Houston where Herman worked as a cost accountant with the Rath Packing Company. They were members of St. Luke's Lutheran Church in Houston where Herman served as Chairman of the Board of Elders and was treasurer for the congregation for 14 years. After Herman and Frances moved back to Northrup in 1980, he and Lummus Hannes started L & H Pumpers which they owned and operated for 22 years. He was an active member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, a founding member of the South Lee County Volunteer Fire Department and a member of the Giddings American Legion York Post 276, volunteering extensively with building projects and fundraisers. Herman enjoyed working word puzzles, watching Wheel of Fortune, gardening, fishing and hunting. He even shot two deer this season at the age of 93. His humble background allowed him to better appreciate and be grateful for all that he obtained and accomplished throughout his life. Herman will be remembered for his love of life, his kindheartedness, and for loving everyone. He was well loved in return.

Herman passed away peacefully the morning of Thursday, January 25, 2024 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin following a long and blessed life.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife of 65 years, Frances Gersch; two brothers and sisters-in-law, Delbert & Olga Mae Gersch and Walter and Laverne Gersch, and one sister and brother-in-law, Leona & Earl Sandoz.

Herman is survived by his two daughters, Cheryl Toff & her husband, Howard of Tucson, Arizona and Cynthia Gersch of Northrup, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and dogs, Luna and Maggie.

Pallbearers will be Mark Schatte, Chris Schatte, Johnny Schatte, Andrew Schatte, Chris Wieder, Garrett Urban, Bryan Gersch, and Dustin Gersch. Honorary pallbearers will be all of Herman's nieces and nephews.

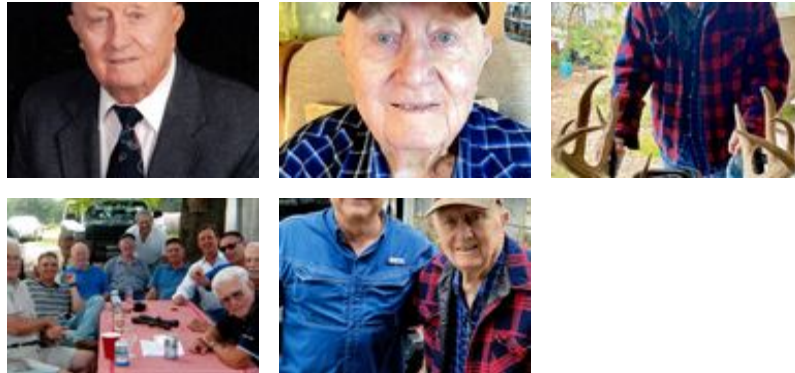

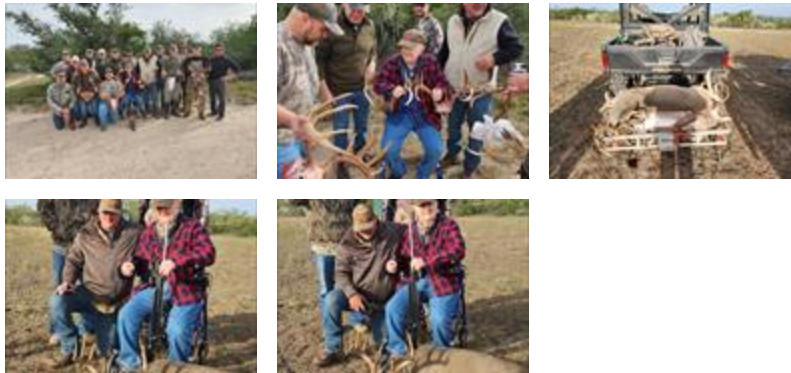
